At the Neue Kantonsschule Aarau, pupils can immerse themselves in other languages and cultures. This is achieved through meticulous language lessons in most of the world's languages, including Chinese and a worldwide exchange programme.

In the Computer Science and Communication apprenticeship, students have to immerse themselves into Computer Science and Communication technologies while learning to assess opportunities and consider the risks of using the world wide web.

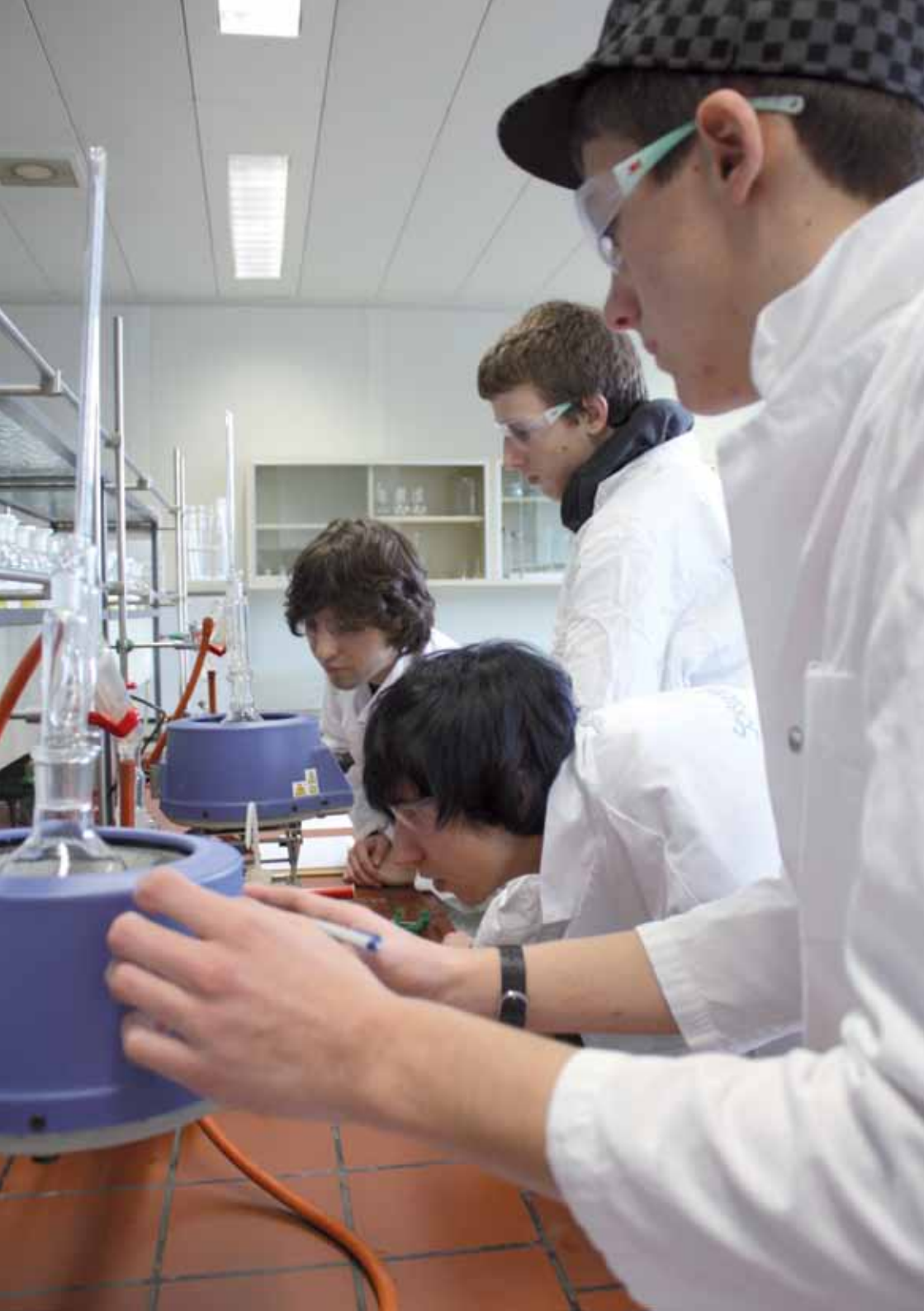

The Neue Kantonsschule Aarau

The straightforward layout of the school grounds of the Neue Kantonsschule Aarau allows concentrated work in peaceful surroundings. We pay attention to detail and build upon the strengths of our pupils. Here are a few examples to show what we mean by that:

Individual support for talented pupils

In the last few years, the Neue Kantonsschule Aarau has been regularly successful with between four and eight Matura theses at the final stages of the «Schweizer Jugend forscht» competition.

Sampling the high-tech world

We work with more than 100 PCs and laptops, two electron microscopes, a laboratory for molecular biology and chemically analytical methods of working, fuel cells or programmable sensor-controlled Mindstorms NTX-robots. Music can also be programmed in the school's own sound laboratory.

Apropos music and theatre

«Lysistrata» by Aristophanes, «Tell it» by Schiller or «Weihnachtsoratorium» by Saint-Saën represent some of the inspiring theatre productions or concerts, the collective choral projects, orchestral, dance and theatre groups. Pupils exceed their expectations and experience diverse forms of artistic expression.

The «Stützpunkt Landenhof-NKSA» Project

Together with the «Landenhof» centre for pupils with impaired hearing the Neue Kantonsschule Aarau has set up a support scheme for pupils with hearing difficulties. In this way, they will be integrated into mainstream lessons.

...and what comes after the NKSA?

Every pupil will be guided by the Neue Kantonsschule Aarau through information and open days on an individual basis on their career choices after the Mittelschule.

Russian, saxophone, mathematics or political debate?

Those who want to understand the world often have to keep an open mind. For this reason, the Neue Kantonsschule Aarau places much value on the wide range of optional subjects on offer.

Among others, there are the **science-orientated optional subjects** such as the Science Practical Work, Mathematics or Political Education. **Music and design optional subjects** include, for example, Musical Ensemble, Jazz Orchestra, Wood- and Metal Work, Theatre Courses, Orchestra or Choir.

Besides the usual **foreign languages**, the Neue Kantonsschule Aarau offers courses in Russian, Chinese and Swedish and prepares the pupils for the most important international language certificates.

Furthermore, we organise accompanied two-week language stays in Spain and England at reasonable prices. **Exchange programmes** with Swiss schools in South America and Spain are also part of what is on offer.



The Gymnasium

Thirst for knowledge and ability is a prerequisite for students who want to attend the Gymnasium. At the Neue Kantonsschule Aarau, they will acquire a broad general education, learn scientific methods and become familiar with foreign languages and cultures. Thus, they will be best prepared for university. Those interested in new media or a bilingual Matura, will find exceptional courses here.

The two-stage Gymnasium education

The Gymnasium education lasts four years. It consists of two stages. That means that the pupils choose an Akzentfach before entering the Gymnasium. This and the Grundlagenfächer will be the focus of the programme of study during the first two years.

Before entering the third year, pupils select their Schwerpunktfach, which is decisive for their future education path. In the fourth year, the Ergänzungsfach is added. It allows for further consolidation, also with a view to the study or career goals.

The Gymnasium is completed with the Matura. This is the only qualification at secondary school level which allows direct entrance to all federal colleges and universities.

The Akzent-, Schwerpunkt- and Ergänzungsfächer

The Neue Kantonsschule Aarau has five **Akzentfächer**: Modern Languages, Mathematics, Latin, Humanitarian- and Social Sciences, as well as Computer Science and Communication (infcom.ch). Part of this will be taught immersively (that is, bilingually) in German and English.

As **Schwerpunktfach**, pupils can choose from: Latin, French, Italian, Spanish, Physics and Applied Mathematics, Biology and Chemistry, Economics and Law, Philosophy/Pedagogy/ Psychology, Visual Arts and Music with instrument lessons.

The **Ergänzungsfächer** are Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Applied Mathematics, Computer Science, History, Geography, Philosophy, Religious Education, Economics and Law, Pedagogy/Psychology, Visual Arts, Music with instrument lessons and Sport.

The NKSA sets special priorities

The Computer Science and Communication Apprenticeships (infcom.ch)

What is Computer Science? How does the web tick?
How do I design a website? How do I set up a data bank?

The internet is constantly changing. New media offers numerous possibilities in which to be informed and exchange ideas, to present oneself and meet people. Just as in real life, this has both positive and negative aspects.

The four-year Gymnasium apprenticeship in Computer Science and Communication gives the pupils enhanced competency in the areas of Computer Science and Communication. They will learn how to combine Computer Science knowledge, Data Bank Programming and New Media, as well as how to set them up. Opportunities will be given to show creative and artistic flair with web tools, podcasts, interactive films and much more. The prospects and dangers of the new media will also be examined in detail.

The apprenticeship is based on the Akzentfach Computer Science and Communication, however, the choice of the Schwerpunktfach and the Ergänzungsfach is however not restricted. In the 3rd and 4th years, the apprenticeship integrates further practical modules and concludes with the Matura.



International Baccalaureate (IB)

The Neue Kantonsschule Aarau offers the future possibility to obtain an internationally recognized diploma together with the Swiss Matura: The International Baccalaureate (IB).

The programme will not only allow students to broaden their English skills but will also introduce them into scientific learning at an advanced level.

The International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Programme is a challenging two-year programme that expands our existing bilingual educational programme. The IB diploma which is obtained in addition to the Swiss Matura is an excellent high quality academic and social education for motivated and gifted students who wish to pursue their future academic studies at home or abroad.

The Fachmittelschule

The Fachmittelschule is a federally recognised Mittelschule which is affiliated with the compulsory schooling time. In the tradition of the early Diplommittelschulen, it provides a broad general education and prepares its pupils with challenging vocational training in five career areas: Education, Design, Health, Social Work and Communication.

The two-stage education

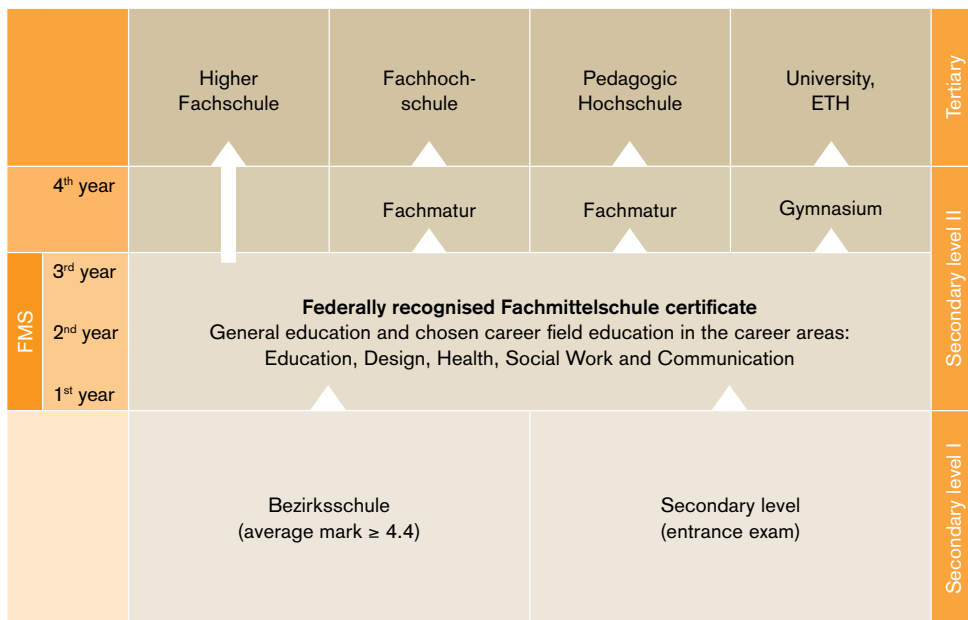
Depending on the qualification sought, the Fachmittelschule lasts three or four years. In three years, pupils attain the Fachmittelschule certificate, which allows direct entry into further education at a higher Fachschule. Students wishing to acquire the Fachmatur, have to pass an additional, mostly practical-based educational module. This fourth year opens up the possibility of pupils being able to continue their education at a Fachhochschule.

General education at the core

Students aiming to complete their qualified vocational training, now require a broad general education also. This general education is at the core of the Fachmittelschule. It is likewise important that the pupils develop and learn how to conduct themselves, in order to take on responsibility.

Within the educational framework of the Fachmittelschule, pupils can attain international certificates within the areas of Languages and Computer Science. Lessons in the chosen career field, work experience in the real world, project weeks, longer independent work, excursions, or the optional subjects, all broaden the pupils' views beyond school and play a vital role in personal development.

During the education at the Fachmittelschule, pupils develop self-discipline and the readiness to take responsibility for their own learning processes. Both are important requirements for successful studies at a higher Fachschule or at a Fachhochschule.

Diverse career prospects

With the Fachmittelschule certificate or the Fachmatur, pupils gain access to sought after vocational trainings. There are five specialisations at the forefront of this:

Education	Teacher at the entry level or the primary level
Design	Fashion Design, Media Art, Visual Communication, Graphic Design, Interior Design
Health	Care, Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, Obstetrics (midwife), Nutrition Counselling, Technical Surgeon's Assistance, Radiology
Social work	Social Education, Social Work, Sociocultural Animation
Communication	Multimedia Design, Computer Science, Specialist Journalism

Who goes to the Fachmittelschule?

The Fachmittelschule is suitable for high-achieving pupils from the Bezirksschule. This option is also open to high-performing secondary pupils who must pass an entrance exam.
